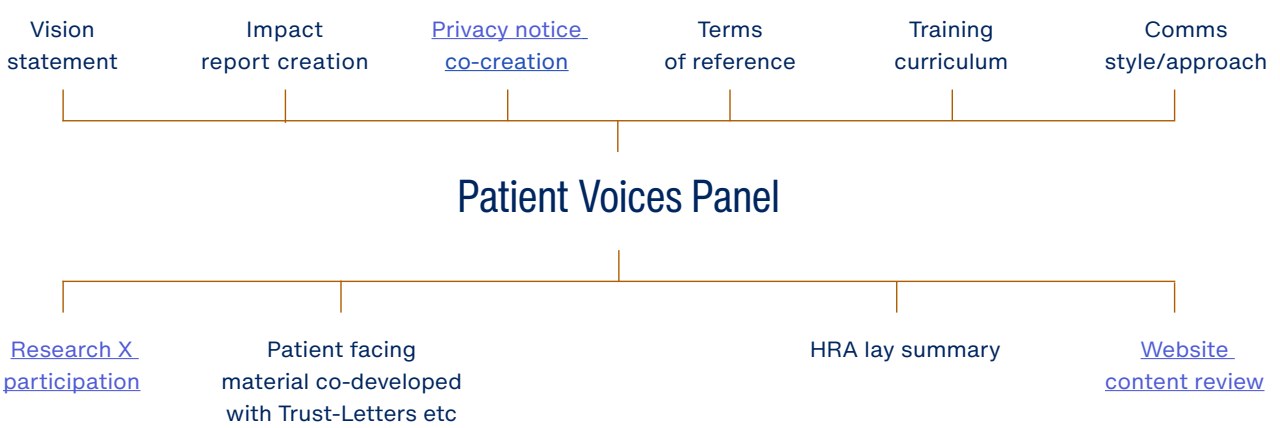

“Open discussions, questions never dodged, meetings are designed to answer the points raised by the panel members, which is good.”

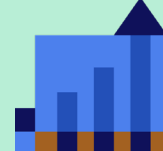
